AHEAD is a Specialist Industry Pathway Program (IPP) involving a two year pathway for students interested in a career within the Health and Education sector.

Involvement with Universities, Registered Training Organisations and local businesses, the AHEAD program is designed to prepare students with the appropriate knowledge and skills to enter the workforce, or complete further education. During stage 1 and stage 2 students complete VET qualifications, achieve SACE completion, and attain an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) in support of a future career in the health and education sector.

The subjects that students will complete are contextualised to their career pathway to encourage student engagement and to equip them with prior industry knowledge. Students will also have the opportunity to be involved in the community and work placement one day a week.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students interested in taking part in this program must have completed the following:

- Grade point average of C grade or above at host school
- Current CV and Interview
- Successful completion of transition day
